Day 2

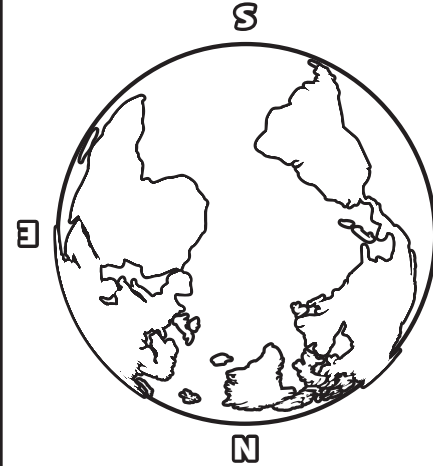

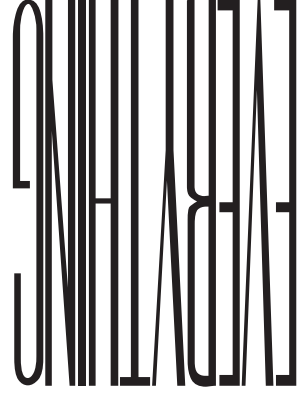
“The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.”
