

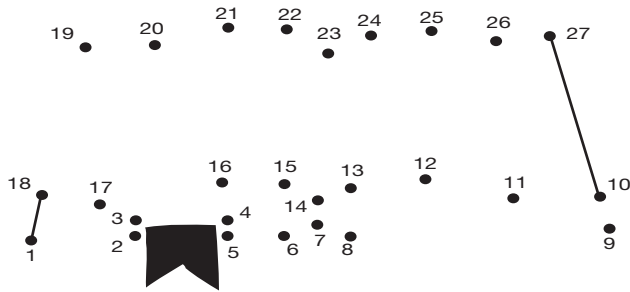
1 READ ABOUT IT!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

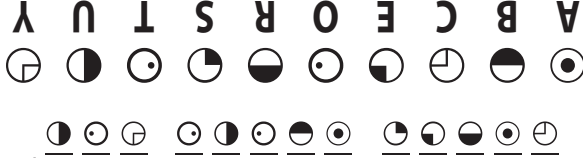
"I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth."

Day 4 **TRUST GOD—HE KEEPS HIS PROMISES!**

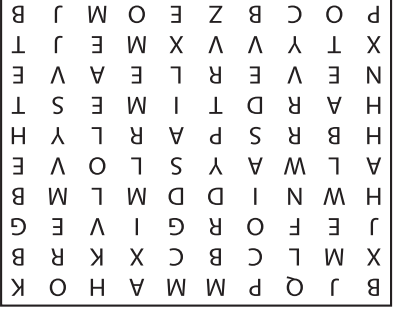
1 READ ABOUT IT!
